No. AAP. 81/2005/65. -- In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Civil Service Rules, 1998, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, namely :-

Short title,
and
commencement.

1. (1) These rules may be called the **Assam Civil Service (Amendment) Rules, 2008.**
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of
Rule 13.

2. In the Principal Rules, in rule 13, existing sub-rules (1), (2), (3) and (4) shall be re-numbered as sub-rules (2), (3), (4) and (5) respectively and before sub-rule (2) so renumbered, the following sub-rule (1) with clauses (a), (b), (c) and (d) thereof shall be inserted, namely :-

"(1)(a) A member of the service in the Junior Grade shall automatically officiate in Senior Grade II time Scale and shall be eligible for drawal of pay and allowances of Senior Grade II time Scale, subject to the conditions that :

- (i) the officer has completed ten years of continuous service in the Junior Grade time scale ;
- (ii) the officer has not received any promotion during the period of ten years as mentioned in sub-clause (i) ;
- (iii) there is no disciplinary or criminal proceeding against the officer ;
- (iv) there shall be a Screening Committee duly constituted by the Government which shall scrutinize the ACR dossiers of the officers before they are given the benefit of the Senior Grade II time scale.

(b) The posts held by the officers falling under clause (a) and fulfilling the conditions mentioned therein, shall be deemed to have been upgraded to Senior Grade II time scale which shall be personal to the officer concerned till the officer is absorbed in a regular vacancy of the Senior Grade II Cadre.

(c) The Officers promoted under clause (a) shall be brought to the regular post under Senior Grade II Cadre as and when vacancy arises in that Grade in due course.

(d) While promoting and regularizing their services in regular cadre as under clauses (b) and (c) the other relevant rules and procedures including reservation policy of the Government shall be followed."
