Provisional pension has been revised in terms of 5th Central Pay Commission recommendation @ Rs.7735 only per month w.e.f. 1.1.1996 (+) plus relief and medical allowances as admissible which was again revised in terms of 6th Central Pay Commission recommendation @ Rs.17,482/- only per month w.e.f. 1.1.2006 (+) plus relief and medical allowances as admissible vide letter No.AAI.72/73/278 dated 8.10.2015 (copy enclosed)

Again Provisional pension was revised in terms of 7th Central Pay Commission recommendation @ Rs.44,930/- only per month w.e.f.1.1.2016 (+) plus relief and medical allowances as admissible vide letter No.AAI.72/73/290 dated 9.11.17 (copy enclosed)

Pension papers has not been forwarded to the Accountant General, Assam in time for finalization of his pension and D.C.R.G as Judicial Proceeding was pending against him. In this connection, a letter was also communicated to the AIG(P), Central Bureau of Investigation, New Delhi seeking a clarification on the status of the matter vide letter No.AAI.72/73/291 dated 14.11.17 (copy enclosed)

You are requested to verify it, there is any outstanding liabilities pending against the officer and if so to make necessary adjustment against the amount of DCRG due to her. ,

The matter was endorsed to the Pension & Public Grievance Department for their views and P&PG Department has conveyed no objection for finalization of the pension & other retirement benefits in respect of Shri Rajaram Misra, IAS (Retd.) in relaxation of Rule 22(1) of the AS(P) Rule,1969 as communicated vide their U.O.176/78 dated 22.5.18.


