O R D E R

Whereas Prosecution Sanction was accorded against Shri Jayanta Sarkar, ACS, the then BDO, Diyungbra Development Block, N.C. Hills, Assam in CBI Case No.RC 5(A) 2011-SHG for committing irregularities in implementation of NREGA schemes vide Order No.AAP 21/2013/352 dated 06.7.2013;

Whereas the Court of the Special Judge, CBI, Assam, Addl. Court No.3, Chandmari, Guwahati vide order dated 30.12.2020 in Special Case No.13/2013 convicted Shri Jayanta Sarkar, ACS and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for 1 (one) year and to pay a fine of Rs.5000/- in default simple imprisonment for another 3 months for the offence committed under section 120B, 468, 471 & 409 of IPC and to suffer simple imprisonment for 1 (one) year and to pay a fine of Rs.20000/- in default SI for another 3 months for the offence under section 13 (1) (c) rw Section 13(2) of P.C. Act;

Whereas after careful examination of the Order dated 30.12.2020 of the Court of Special Judge, CBI, Assam in Special Case No.13/2013 and materials on record, the Disciplinary Authority has decided to inflict the penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Shri Jayanta Sarkar, ACS;

Whereas the Assam Public Service Commission on being consulted in the matter, has vide their U.O. issue No.1612 Dtd. 08.02.2022 agreed to the proposed penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Shri Jayanta Sarkar, ACS

Now, therefore, the Governor of Assam in exercise of powers conferred under Article 311(2)(a) of the Constitution of India and Rule 10(i) of the Assam Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1964 is pleased to impose the penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Shri Jayanta Sarkar, ACS under Rule 7(vii) of the Assam Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1964 with immediate effect.
