O R D E R

Whereas Prosecution Sanction was accorded against Smti Nandita Konwar, ACS, the then Project Director, DRDA, Kamrup (M) vide Order No.AAP 505/2015/124 dated 16.3.2017 in ACB PS Case No.10/2015 for illegally demanding and accepting bribe for release of payment in respect of MPLADS work;

Whereas the Court of the Special Judge, Assam, vide order dated 08.4.2021 in Special Case No.22/2017 convicted Smti Nandita Konwar under sections 7/13 (2) of P.C.Act, 1988 and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 3 (three) years and also pay fine of Rs.12,000/- (rupees twelve thousand) in default rigorous imprisonment for 1 (one) month under section 7 of P.C.Act, 1988 and also sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 4 (four) years and also pay fine of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) in default rigorous imprisonment for 2 (two) months under section 13(2) of P.C Act, 1988. It was ordered that both the sentences will run concurrently;

Whereas after careful examination of the Order dated 08.4.2021 of the Court of Special Judge, Assam in Special Case No.22/2017 and materials on record, the Disciplinary Authority has decided to inflict the penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Smti Nandita Konwar, ACS;

Whereas the Assam Public Service Commission on being consulted in the matter, has vide their U.O. issue No.1611 Dtd. 04.2.2022 agreed to the proposed penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Smti Nandita Konwar, ACS

Now, therefore, the Governor of Assam in exercise of powers conferred under Article 311(2) of the Constitution of India and Rule 10 of the Assam Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1964 is pleased to impose the penalty of 'Dismissal from Service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment' upon Smti Nandita Konwar, ACS, Editor in Chief, District Gazetteers, Assam under Rule 7(vii) of the Assam Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1964 with immediate effect.


